UNICEF provides services to children, youth and adults. This agency works in more than 190 countries and territories. UNICEF also provides humanitarian and development aid to children in each corner of the world.

This agency was created on December 11th 1946 (after World War II) in New York, and in 1953 the agency became a permanent part of the United Nations System, so its name was subsequently changed to its current form.



The Libyan website of Unicef has lots of interesting information and pictures of what they are doing here.




P<sup>ro</sup>sperity will be achieved when you stand for a mix of E<sup>quality</sup> and justice.

## Book Review: Trash


